

Instructions to Request A Temporary Modification Of A Liquor Licensed Premises Due to COVID-19 Social Distancing Requirements

Before applying for a temporary liquor modification, you must execute an agreement for use of a parklet or an outdoor dining license.

- 1) Complete Colorado Department of Revenue Form DR 8442
 - o Page 1:

Section C: Select "Change, Alter, Modify Premises."

- o Page 9:
 - 9 (a): In the description of the proposed change, you must include, "Due to COVID-19" after the description.
 - 9 (b): End date: October 30, 2021.
 - 9 (c): Confirm the location of proposed licensed premise.
 - 9 (d): Confirm compliance with local land use codes.
 - 9 (e): Applications associated with this request are not Optional Premises.
- 2) You must attach the following to the application:
 - A map showing the current liquor licensed premises. (The Clerk's Office will not reuse maps submitted in 2020. Please submit new diagrams.)
 - o A **second map** showing the proposed extension outlined in **red ink**.
 - o A **signed agreement** with the Town of Telluride for use of the public right-of-way. If on **private property**, approval from property owner through a **lease agreement or letter of approval**.
 - o A plan titled "Liquor Control Plan" including pertinent details to help explain your specific request and measures which shall be taken to:
 - Control ingress and egress;
 - Prevent alcohol being removed from or brought onto the licensed premises;
 - Prevent the sale of alcoholic beverages to minors, and
 - Prevent the sale of alcoholic beverages to intoxicated parties.
- 3) Email application and attachments to the Telluride Clerks Department: clerks@telluride-co.gov or drop off at Town Hall, 135 W Columbia Avenue. (There are no fees. The State of Colorado waived fees through December 07, 2021. There are no local fees.)

What happens after I submit my application?

- You must receive approval from the Town of Telluride AND the State of Colorado before liquor service may begin in the proposed area.
- o Once an application has been submitted, you will receive a confirmation email from the Clerk's Office.

- o If there are any items outstanding, you will be notified before the application can be processed.
- o Once an application is deemed complete, it will be emailed to the State of Colorado Department of Revenue for approval.
- The Town of Telluride requires a 48-hour public notice for temporary modifications due to COVID-19. The Clerk's Office will email you a 11" x 17" public notice poster that you can print and hang in a publicly visible location.
 - The Clerk's Office can also print the notice for you and coordinate pick-up of the notice if you do not have the ability to print 11" x 17'
- o After the public notice is posted, return the Certificate of Posting emailed to you with the public notice to clerks@telluride-co.gov to confirm the public notice was posted.
- o After 48 hours the Town Clerk will address any remonstrances received. If none are received, local approval may be granted administratively by the Town Clerk.
- Once approval is received from the State, the Town Clerk will email you the State and Town permits.
 - The Clerk's Department will also forward licensees required signage:
 - (1) No Alcohol Beyond This Point
 - (2) No Hitching Of Animals, Bikes, Strollers
 - (3) State of Colorado Mask Requirements

PLEASE BE ADVISED

- o If a parklet is approved, patrons may not transport alcohol from the liquor establishment. Only employees of the liquor licensed establishment may transport alcohol beverages to the parklet.
- A parklet is an extension of your licensed premises. Alcohol may not be removed from the parklet by patrons nor may outside alcohol be brought into the parklet.
- You must receive approval from the Town of Telluride AND the State of Colorado before liquor service may begin in the proposed area.
- The **deadline** to submit an application for a temporary modification under an *expedited review and approval* process is **May 18**, **2021**. Applications received after May 18, 2021 must go before the Liquor Licensing Authority and post a public notice for ten days.
- o Applications for a permanent modification of a liquor licensed premises are not eligible for an expedited review and approval process.
